OUTER DOCK DAMAGE:

- The south end center floating dock got hung up on the piling rings at an extremely low tide. The rings did not move freely with the rising tide and held the southwest corner of the dock by slip 98 under water.
- This caused torque, stress and fractures, which damaged the dock structure. Fortunately, the billets (floatation) were not affected. Most of the area had to be reinforced, repaired, and/or replaced. The costs for this project will be taken out of the Scheduled Expenditures Account.
- While doing the above work, it was discovered that additional work is needed north of the completed area. Thank you for your patience as we proceed with these repairs.
- Thank you to:
 - o Darin Stormer (slip 72) for noticing and reporting the dock damage AND for suggesting a contractor.
 - o Scott Thompson (slip 81) for his help in removing the piling rings and damaged boards that were binding the piling rings. This removal allowed the dock to float freely and prevented additional damage.

MAINTENANCE ITEMS COMPLETED:

- <u>Outer Docks</u> Pilings and piling rings were checked; the main water line, pedestal faces at slip 81 & slip 74/75 were repaired; faucet was replaced and water leak was fixed at slip 83; light bulb was changed at slip 74/75; meter base was checked at slip 78; faucet by freeze protector was replaced; latch, hinges and spring on outer dock gate were lubed; piling rings and header on south end of outer dock were removed..
- <u>Inner Docks</u> Pedestal bulb was replaced; broken water line at slip 00 was repaired; 80 hooks for Christmas lights were installed; leaning finger piers slips 10/11 & 12/13 were checked; slip number at 3, 24 & 31 were replaced/repaired.
- Other Christmas decorations were removed and stored

<u>YC SLIP 82</u> – We are in the process of listing this for sale with a realtor. (Hopefully, we can sell this slip soon, and put the proceeds into the Designated Funds Account.

- Parking Lots and Trailer Lots Valuations all decreased from the 2012 value. (see above)
- **Inner Marina** Valuation was reduced.
 - O Data was sent to the authorities <u>prior</u> to the 2017 assessment containing 2015-2016 slip sale information for inner docks, since there is no public recording of our Membership Sales.
- Outer Docks Valuation increased \$1,010,800 from the 2012 value.
 - Informal Appeal has been filed with an attachment listing the 2015-2016 slip sale information for the
 outer docks (the fair market values no foreclosures or short sales; no sales associated with other sales of
 property (e.g. condo or house).
